

Global Water Research Coalition at TZW

End of September 2017 the meeting of Managing and Executive Directors of GWRC's members took place at TZW. The Global Water Research Coalition (GWRC) is a non-profit organisation that serves as the collaborative mechanism for water research. The services the GWRC offers its members is water research information and knowledge. The mission of GWRS is to maintain a strong partnership between world leading water research organisations to generate, exchange and communicate knowledge through research collaborations to support safe and sustainable water supply and sanitation for the protection of public health and the aquatic environment. 14 members all over the globe from Asia, Australia, North America, South Africa and Europe are jointly working together on strategic water research topics. Additionally, GWRC is affiliated with the International Water Association (IWA) and US Environmental Protection Agency (US-EPA). At the moment TZW is chairing the coalition for a period of three years.

At the strategic Board meeting GWRC's research agenda was evaluated and up-dated. Additionally, the topics microplastics, antibiotic resistance, trace compound strategies, phosphor recycling and energy efficiency in the water sector were detailed discussed.
